Per your invitation for me to keep you informed of the outcome, I have attached the results of the court's decision regarding the release of addresses to the PWCP.

I hope that this will clear up our working relationship, and the PWCP will begin receiving Certified Payroll Record's (CPR's) from the County of Sacramento per California Labor Code 1776(e).

I have two sets of CPR's that were received from the County Public Works Department that do not include the addresses, and I would like to have new copies sent that will be inclusive of this information. The projects are County contract numbers (3839)-Carmichael Library Remodel and (3843)-Juvenile Hall Expansion and Mods.

If this decision can be shared with the County of Sacramento Public Works Department, I'm hopeful that they will reproduce the copies dated March 7, 2006 for the aforementioned contracts without the workers addresses obliterated.

Dear Mr. Abram,
Since my last email to you dated September 7, 2005, regarding the subject matter, I have been contacted by attorneys representing Helix Electric. They inform me that a challenge brought in the California Department of Industrial Relations has been initiated by the California Division of Labor Standards Enforcement (DLSE) to, among other things, dispute the legal status of your organization as a joint labor-management committee established pursuant to the federal Labor Management Cooperation Act of 1978 (29 U.S.C. Sec. 175a), and to dispute its derivative right to receive employee addresses under California Labor Code section 1776(e). In that regard, Helix' attorneys have requested that the County refrain from reporting addresses of Helix' employees to your organization for at least 30 days, pending resolution of this matter. In light of this, please be advised that pending resolution of that question, this office has recommended that the County of Sacramento decline to provide employee addresses to your organization.
